- *When driving, increase your following distance from 3-4 seconds to 5-6 seconds. It takes longer to slow down and stop on icy roads.




Balconies are beautiful so let's keep them that way. Please do not store any items on your balcony including but not limited tires, bikes, Christmas decorations, furniture to name just a few.
