Air Conditioning Units

Reminder: The cost for air conditioning is \$80 for the season/AC.

Parking related changes/updates

Parking Tags

Parking tags must be displayed in your car to be easily seen by the superintendent. Any vehicle without a tag will be ticketed and towed at the owner's expense. Anyone with a second vehicle and does not have a parking tag, please see your superintendent to fill out a form for a tag.

The replacement of a lost parking tag will be \$10.00

Please note: not all buildings have 2nd car parking available. Please contact superintendent before getting a 2nd a vehicle.



Balcony Rules

Please ensure that nothing at all is being drilled into the brick or attached onto the balcony railings.

BBQ on balconies: open burning is not permitted on balconies of residential buildings, only electric barbecues.

When **watering** your plants please do not over fill the pots and allow water to travel down to your neighbours

If you are uncertain as to whether you are allowed to have something on your balcony, please contact our office for clarification.

Rent Due Date

Rent is due on the 1st day of the month but however the superintendent will still bring it to the office up to the 3rd day of the month After the 3rd day it will not be the superintendents' responsibility to get your payment to the office.

Once we deposited a cheque, we are not able undo it up and hold it.
